Winter Weather and OCPC

While December 21 marked the "official" beginning of Winter, we know that it really arrived the first weekend of December and has kept coming back each of these past 3 Sundays. For the first time in many years, we had to cancel worship on two consecutive Sundays. While one snow day can be fun, two is too many and a big hassle to cancel. It is difficult to notify everyone of such cancelations. For the rest of the winter, we will attempt not to cancel. If the weather makes travel difficult, and it is not recommended by the DOT or County, or if there is a Winter Storm Warning for a Sunday, we will not hold a regular worship service. While a formal service may not be held, we will keep the doors open for anyone who can walk or has a short drive, and wishes to come to share in the liturgy and a warm cup of coffee. This will be at your own discretion. Pastor Scott, like many of our members, lives a long way from Cambridge, and may not make it. It is rare that this will happen, though as we know now, it does happen. So please check your email, voice mail, or the church Facebook page for weather updates and possible changes in worship service or other activities.

SESSION NOTES

Due to the inclement weather in December, regular stated Session meetings scheduled for December 11th and 18th were canceled. On Tuesday, December 20th a stated Session meeting was held to take care of important financial business. Pastor Scott opened and closed the meeting with prayer.

- Treasurer's reports and financials were discussed. Pledge offerings are down this month due to canceled services. Snow plowing costs have increased. A reminder of the need for continuing giving will be sent by email to members.
- The Bernice Gillingham fund has grown significantly this year. The amount eligible to be withdrawn this year will be transferred to the Hazel Main fund, which is more easily accessible.
- Manse update—a new 12 month lease will be offered to our tenant. He will also be asked to shovel the sidewalks, etc. around the church whenever volunteers Touhey and Thiltgen are unavailable. He will be paid for the gas used and his services.
- Thank you to Jerry Thiltgen for the donation of a snow blower to the church.
- The Pastor's contract for 2017 was reviewed and approved, increasing his hours to 50%, or 20 hours/week and changing his benefits. A few details still need to be worked out between the Personnel Committee and Pastor.
- Our Session records have been reviewed by the JKPresbytery Stated Clerk and approved with no exceptions. Thank you to Ruth Poole for her excellent recordings. This volume contains minutes from 18 years of Session meetings. Earlier volumes go back to the founding of the church.
- Upcoming holiday events were reviewed.
- The Sunday School Pageant has been rescheduled for Sunday, January 8 during worship. It was canceled December 18 due to the weather.
- The nominating committee will meet soon.
- The Annual Meeting of the Congregation will be held Sunday, January 29, 2017 following worship. This meeting will also include nominations, election, and installation of church officers.
- The 2017 church budget will be very similar to 2016's. Any suggestions for changes should be given to the Finance Committee.
