Some of our pews are going to good homes, like a school choir room and library.



You will notice that we are not just getting rid of some pews, but we are really working to create a more welcoming, usable worship space. With no choir, we moved those pews, situating them in the front rows, while moving the piano up on to the chancel. This opens up our worship space for baptisms, funerals, weddings, children's programs, when we have special music, and for decorating at Christmas and Easter.
