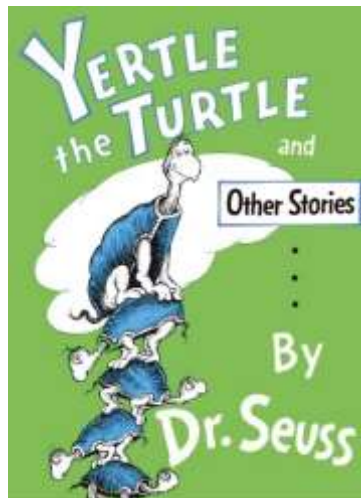


To Members and Friends of Oakland-Cambridge Presbyterian Church,
