

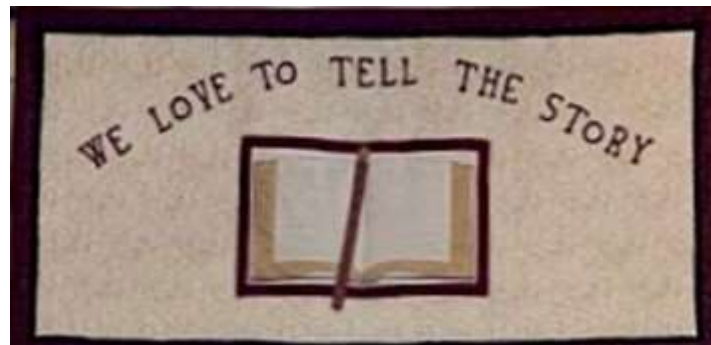

## **UPDATE FROM SESSION CONCERNING MASKS FOR VACCINATED AND UNVACCINATED PEOPLE IN WORSHIP.**

People who are fully vaccinated will no longer need to wear a mask inside. People who are not vaccinated are encouraged to please continue wearing a mask out of concern for their own health and the health and safety of others. While we will not be asking who are and are not vaccinated, we pray you will be respectful of the needs of all. While we continue to see light at the end of the pandemic tunnel because of the vaccine, we know that the COVID-19 virus and its variants are still active. We are also aware that some people, even if they have been vaccinated, might still choose to wear a mask inside. Please do as you feel comfortable. The Session is mindful of the anxiety many people have about reconnecting with groups of people, even small in number as we are, after such a period of time. We are also mindful of the health issues of a number of our members, some who wish to be in worship for their own spiritual and mental health. If you have not been vaccinated, we encourage you to do so. Thank you for understanding as we seek to love and care for each other, including the vulnerable among us.
