

## **NARRATIVE LECTIONARY RETURNS**


Prior to the pandemic, we were reading through the Narrative Lectionary, a Four-Year Cycle that takes us through the whole of the Bible and each of the Gospels. You might remember, we would read a longer Bible passage as a Readers Theatre. We will be returning to this beginning on September 11 beginning with the Flood Narrative in Genesis 6-9. Our Narrative Lectionary readings begin in the Hebrew Scriptures with Genesis, and go through Advent. In December we will begin to read through the whole of the Gospel of Matthew. Each Sunday, we will have various parts for individuals and the congregation to share in for the Readers Theatre. Prior to the readings, I will offer a “Previously” or “Building the Bridge” from the prior weeks reading to the current Sunday’s reading.
