THIS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, we dry things out a bit, moving from the flood narrative to the first Call Narrative, as we hear the story of the call of Abram and Sarai. Notice at this point in the story, they do not have their more familiar names. This new God who calls to them, invites them to leave behind all they have known their family, friends, home, their familiar way of life, and connection to their ancestral past journey into an unknown future, trusting this unknown Deity and untested promise, risking it all for a for nothing more than a promise of a blessing. How would we respond as a congregation if God called us to leave behind what we have valued as a church, and invited us, like Abram and Sarai, into a new, unknown future way of being the people of God? Would we take God up and follow? What if Abram and Sarai had stayed at home? What if Peter, James and John had remained fisherman and not followed Jesus? Join us this Sunday as we reflect together on God's call into this unknown future and our response. Worship is at 10 a.m.
