**THE SEXUAL ASSAULT OF JOSEPH  
GENESIS 39:1-23  
SEPTEMBER 25  
10 AM**

**THIS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 25**, we continue the Narrative Lectionary moving from the call of Abraham to the sons of Jacob, focusing on Jacob's one son, Joseph. While most of us know Joseph's story through the musical about his multicolored dreamed coat, many of us do not know in the Bible story, Joseph is actually the victim of sexual assault. Sexual

violence and rape are found through the scriptures. Sadly, sexual violence and harassment have long been and continue to be an issue in the Church today. It is important for us to break the silence, address this issue in worship, listen to the voices of those long silenced by the church, show our support, in order to bring healing to the victims. We will be doing so through the story of Joseph who is sexually assaulted by Potiphar's wife. Yes, men are also victims of sexual abuse.
